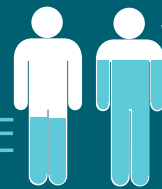
This year, Project HOME began regular street outreach in Kensington, partnering with Prevention Point and others to provide services to individuals.

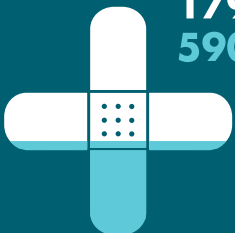
