Why the need for hygiene kits?

The Philadelphia Outreach Coordination Center [OCC] engages thousands of individuals experiencing chronic homelessness each year. As OCC teams assess the needs of the individuals, they also provide resources towards housing stability, such as shelters, safe havens, transitional housing, etc. Teams carry hygiene kits as an additional resource to offer individuals a small assortment of basic toiletries and snacks. This small kit [or bag] is a simple resource that educates and create awareness towards the issue of Homelessness that effects not only Philadelphia, but our country as whole.

Who participates?

Creating hygiene kits is an activity for everyone! This opportunity creates awareness towards Homelessness in Philadelphia and as well educates participants on current policies and programs in place to help those experiencing homelessness.
